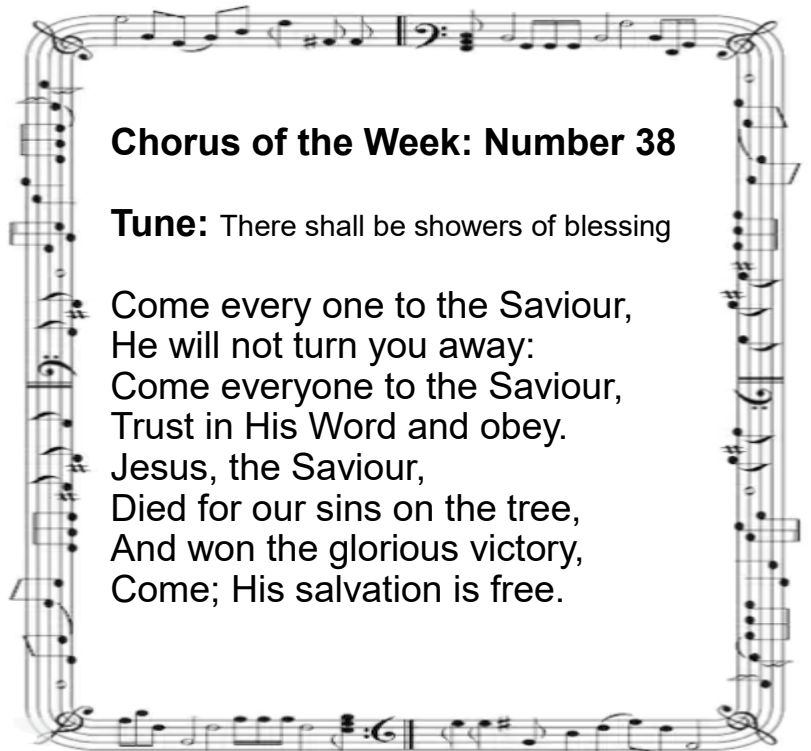

Prophecy: The Lord Jesus Enters Jerusalem

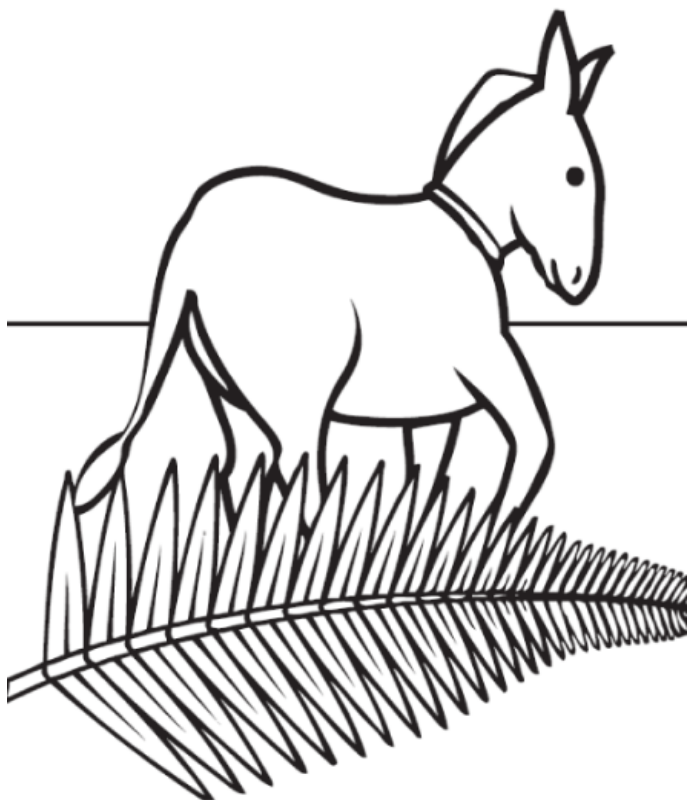
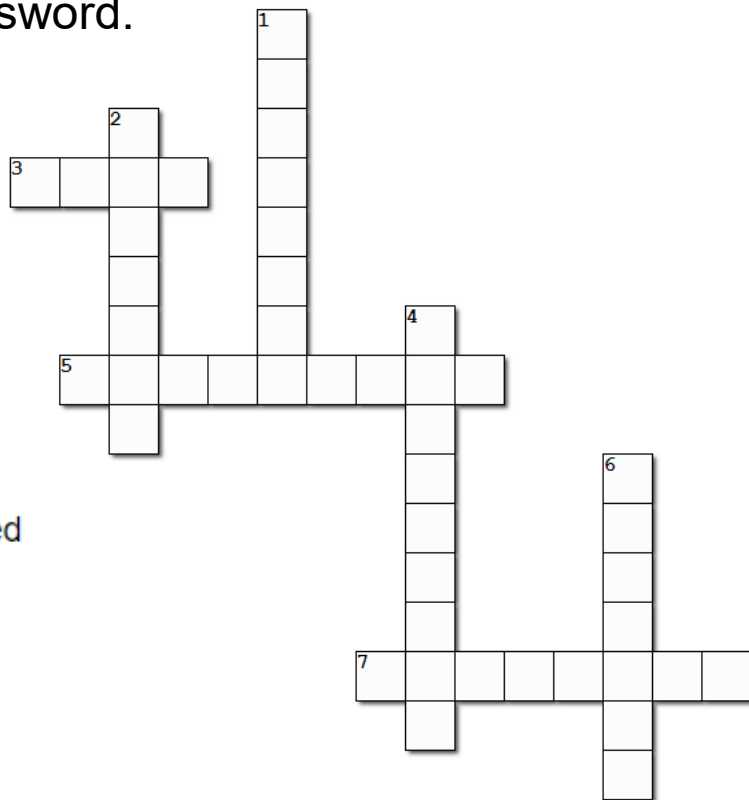

Story Time

Ruth and her Mum and Dad lived a little bit outside a market town in the West of Ireland.

"Mum," said Ruth, "When can we get more groceries? It seems like we are eating the same thing every day."

"I know," answered Mum, "our stocks are running low. We really need to go to town to get some supplies."

Conversations like this were being had in homes all over Ireland.

It was the year 1947 and Ireland had its longest cold and snowy winter that anybody could recall. The snow was so deep in places that families couldn't leave their houses and only people involved in essential services went out. Sick people had to be attended to, animals had to be fed, and grocery shops had to try and keep stocked up.

Then a neighbour farmer had a really good idea. He had two big strong horses and he thought he could use them to make a path. So he hitched the horses up to a wide cart and drove them out onto the road. Then with great effort they slowly pulled the cart through the snow all the way into town. They had to battle their way through high snow drifts and find the twists and turns in the road, but eventually they reached the town and, after a little rest, the farmer turned them around and came all the way back. Everyone on that road was delighted because now there was a path through the snow and it wasn't long before Ruth and her Mum were walking home from town with their shopping baskets full.



All the people needed to get into town, but there was no way they could get there by their own efforts because of the snow. But one man was able to open up the way by tackling the dangers of the snow himself. Once it was open all the people had to do was use the way he had provided. Just like this, there is no way we can get to Heaven by our own efforts because of our sin. But one Man, the Lord Jesus Christ, has opened up the way by suffering for our sins on the cross. Now He is the Way to Heaven, and we can be sure of getting there by accepting Him as our Saviour. In John's gospel the Lord Jesus said:
