# Story Time

On Ben's eighth birthday, his parents bought him a little puppy. Ben was very excited and he loved his little dog. He decided to call him Foxy. Everyone in the family loved him, and little Foxy loved them all, but he was Ben's special pet, and it was Ben who gave him his food every day, and cleaned up after him if he made a mess.
