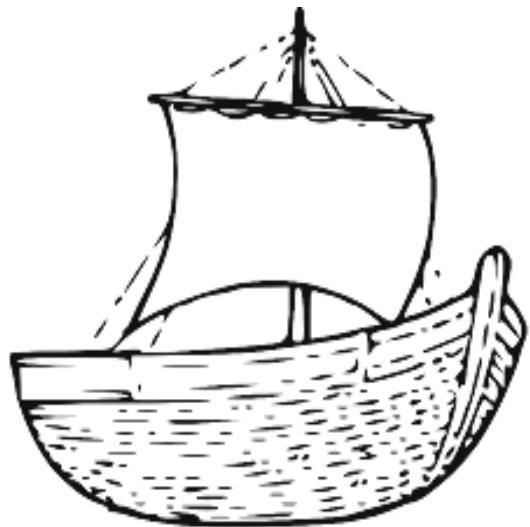
He was not that Light, but was sent to

A GREAT STORM

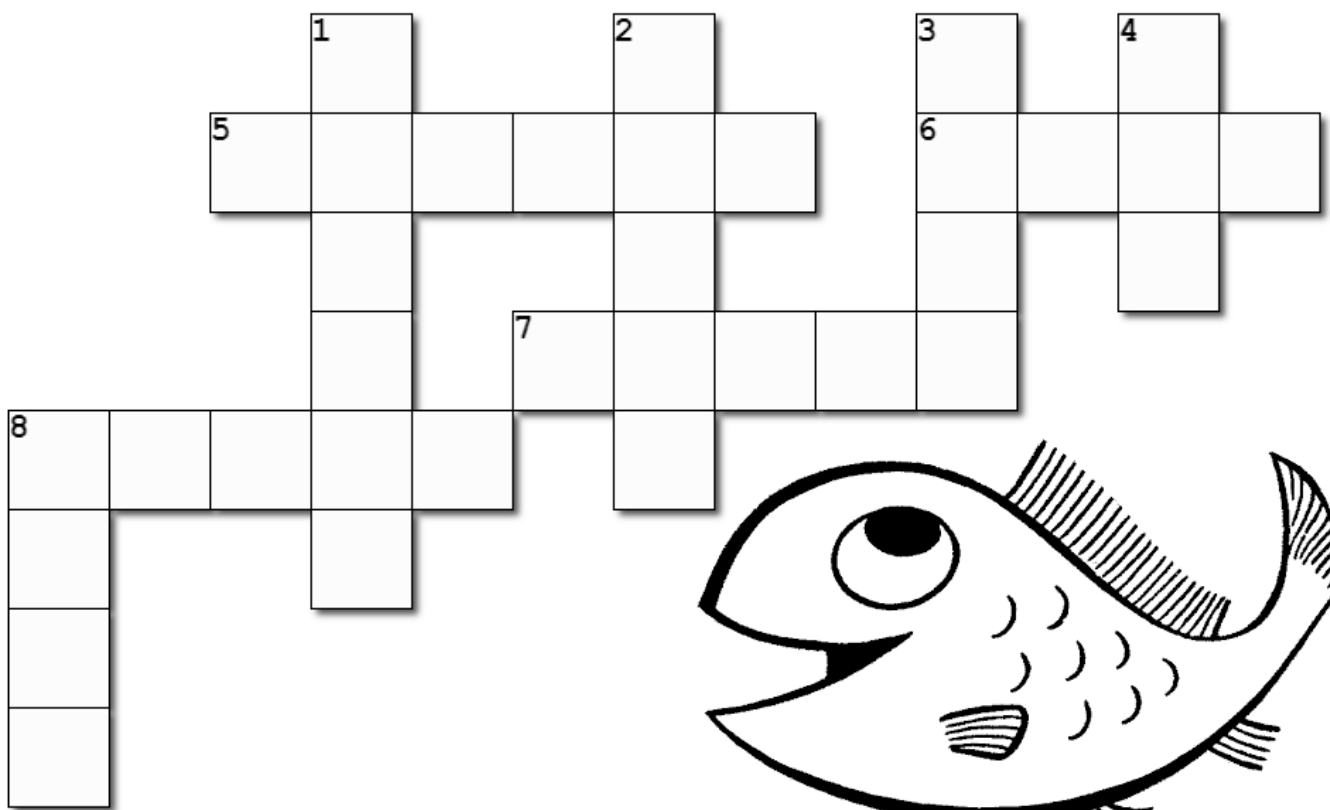


A GREAT CALM
